Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj, also known by the names Shahu or Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj, was the first king or Maharaja of Kolhapur. He was from the 'Bhonsle' family of the Maratha rulers. He governed from 1894-1922.

Shahu Maharaj was a social reformer, highly influenced by Mahatma Jyotiba Phule. He was born on June 26, 1874, and breathed his last on May 6, 1922, at the age of 47.

The 147th birth anniversary of Lokraja Rajrshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj was celebrated with great enthusiasm like every year at Dr. J. J. Magdum College of Engineering, Jaysingpur.

The program started with the worship of Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj. His photo was worshiped by the Vice Principal sir, Prof. A.M. Naniwadekar.
