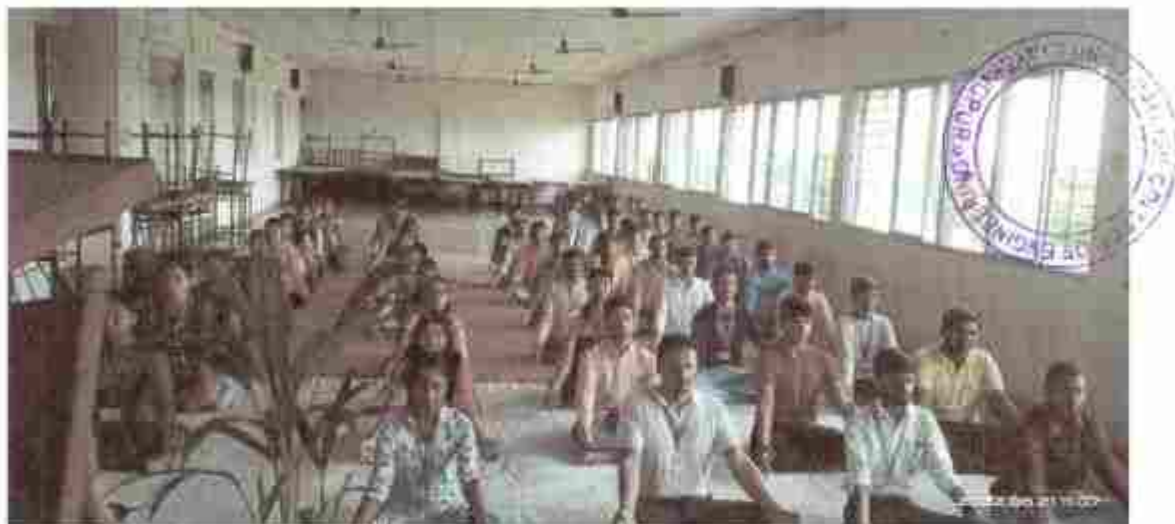

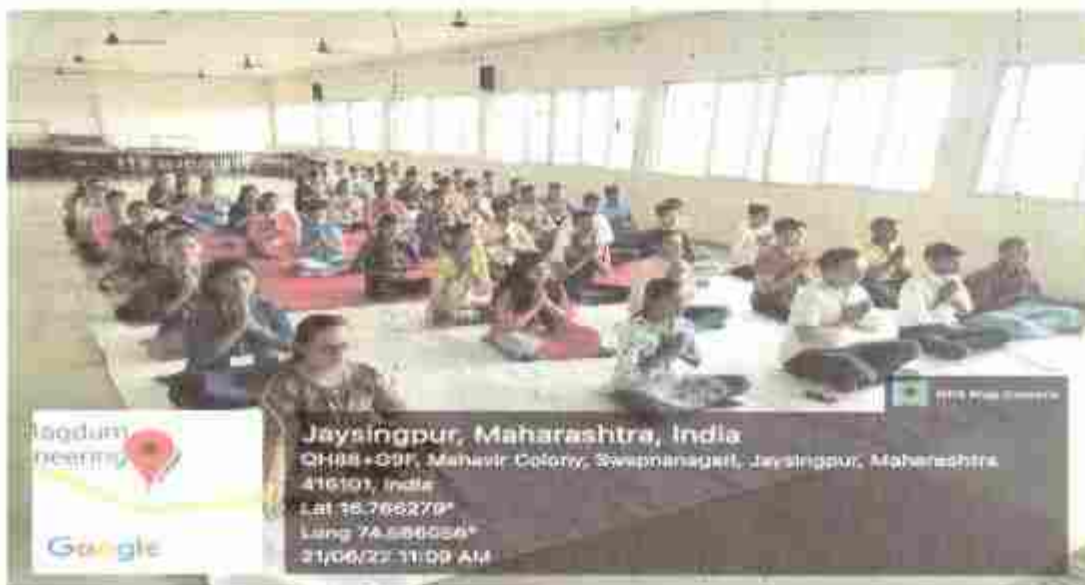

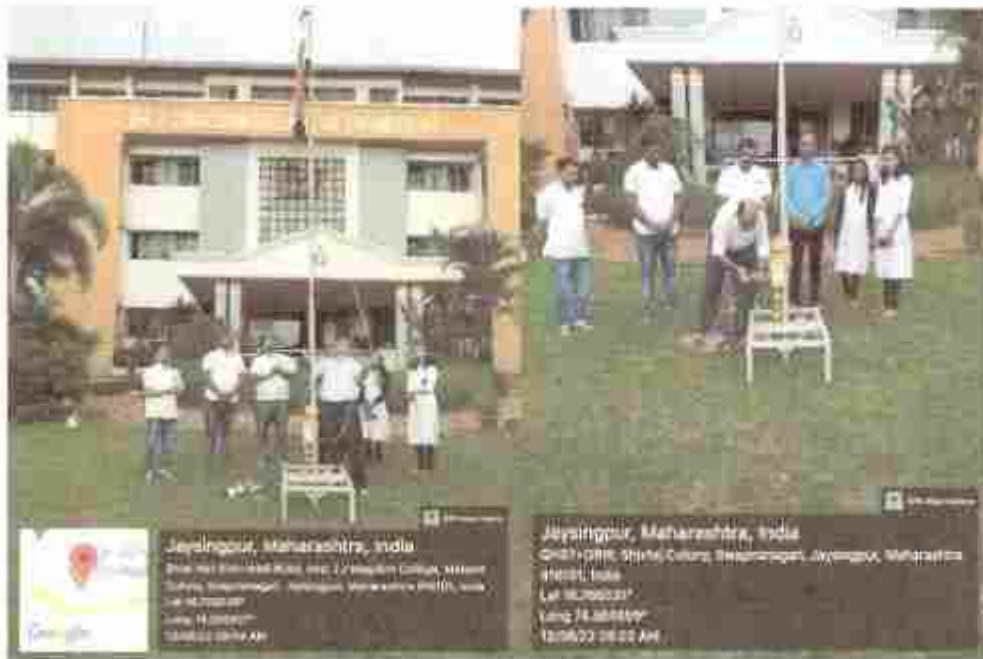

The event was a great success.



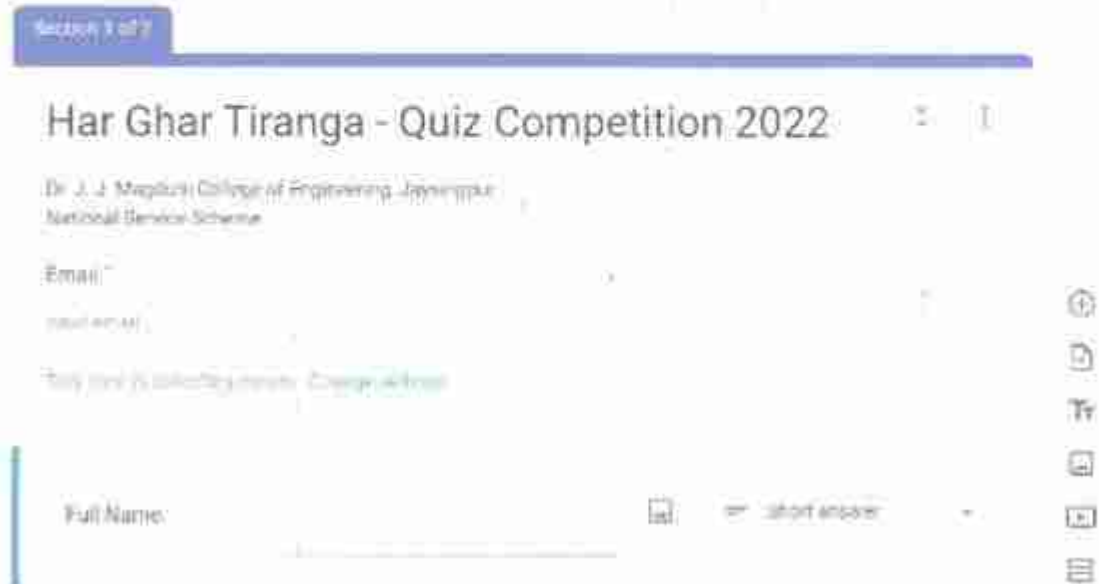
Distribution of Pamphlets with Flag Code of India (J.J.Magdum Housing Society)

Ganesh Chaturthi was celebrated all over India. Every year the festival starts and ends with great pomp and fun. The festival was celebrated for a period of 10 days. Ganesh idols are immersed into rivers or lakes. With the passion of celebrating this festival, we generally forget the hazardous impact of the immersion of idols on environment. The idol of Ganesh is generally made up of clay, Plaster of Paris (POP), plastic and cement. Toxic paints are also used in decorating the idol. After the immersion, the ingredients of the idols does not completely dissolve in water which then leads to environmental pollution.

In addition to this, these idols are often colored with bright paints that contain heavy metals such as lead, nickel, cadmium, and mercury. These heavy metals can affect the PH balance of the water, making it more acidic and thus further poisoning its inhabitants. Additionally, these materials can cause skin diseases in humans when they come into contact with the water, as well as poisoning us through the fish and birds eaten as food. That's why we NSS unit conducted competition for celebration of Ecofriendly Ganesh decoration competition for awareness of Environmental Protection.

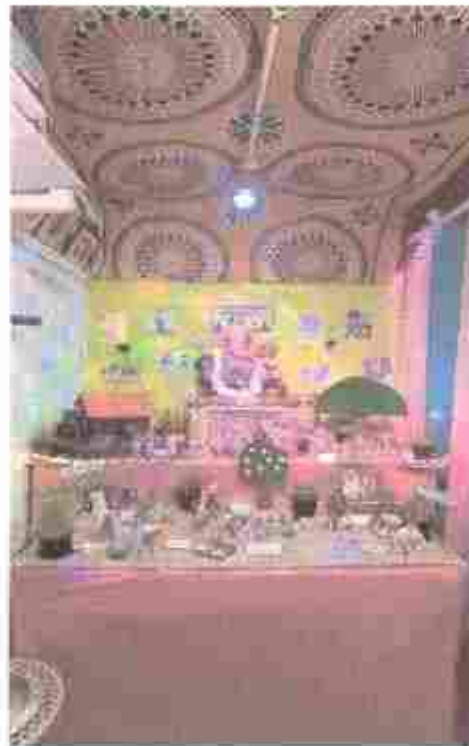

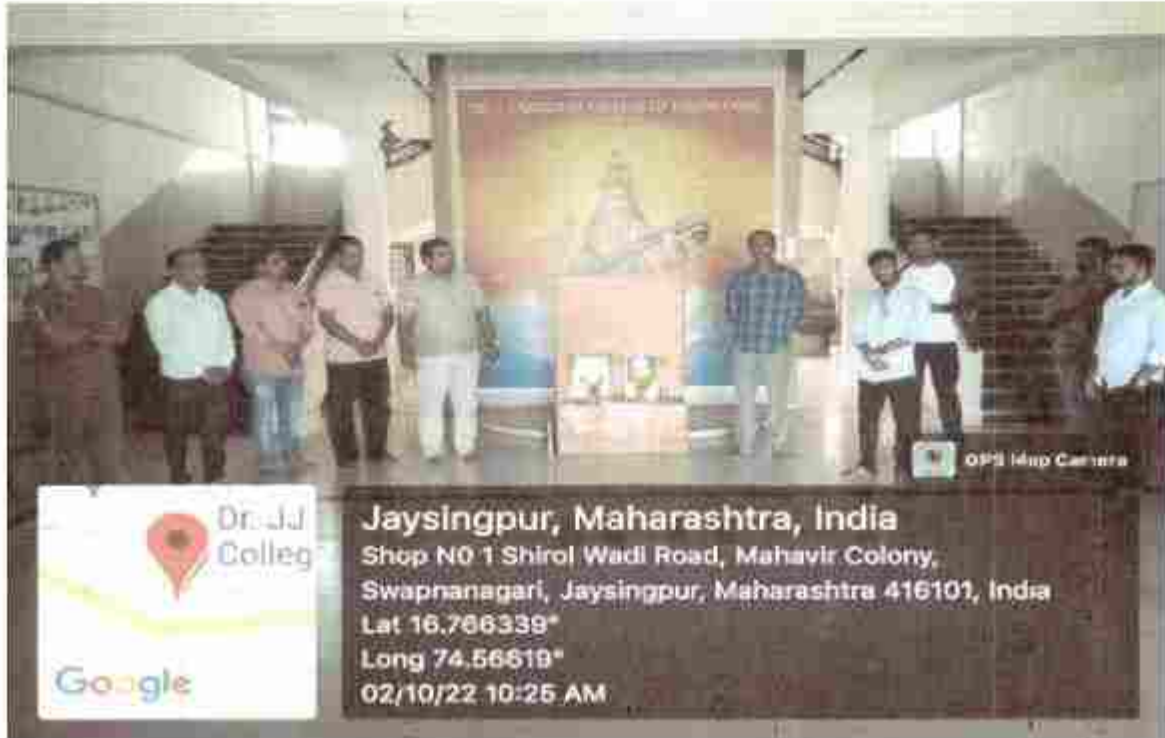

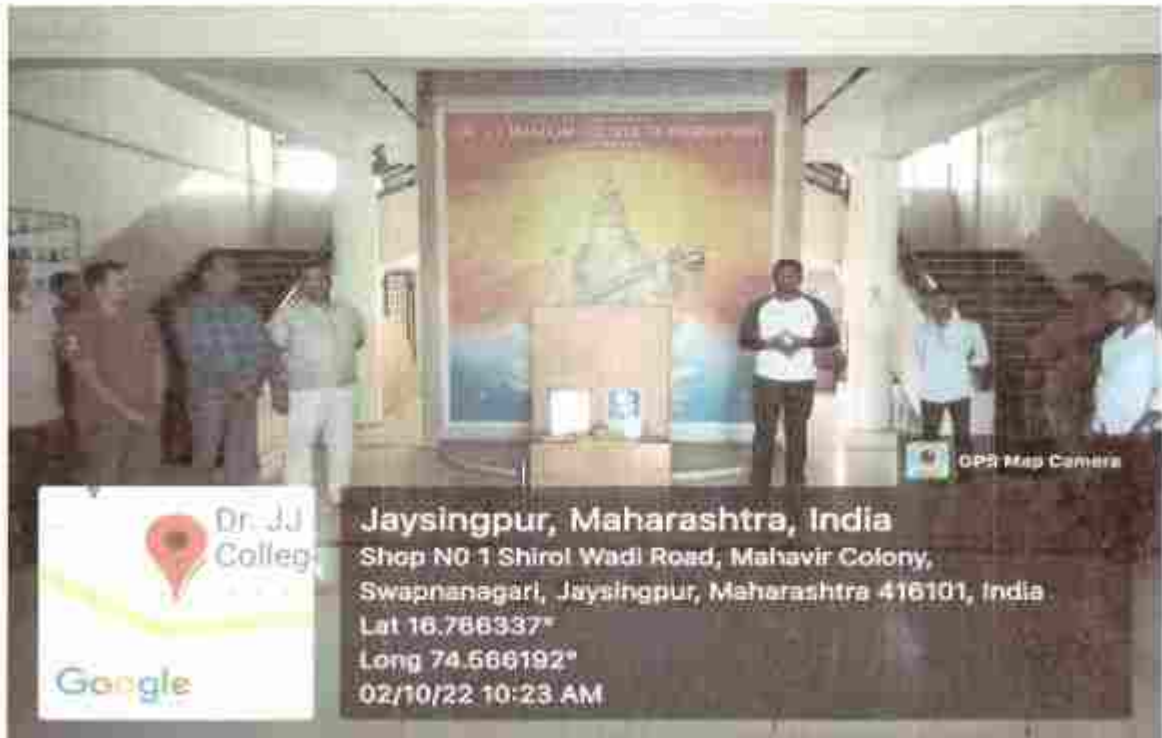

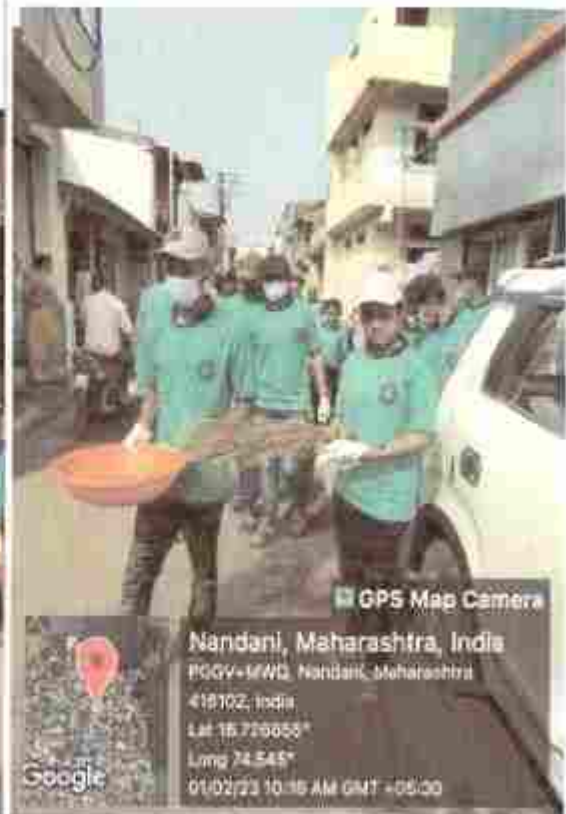
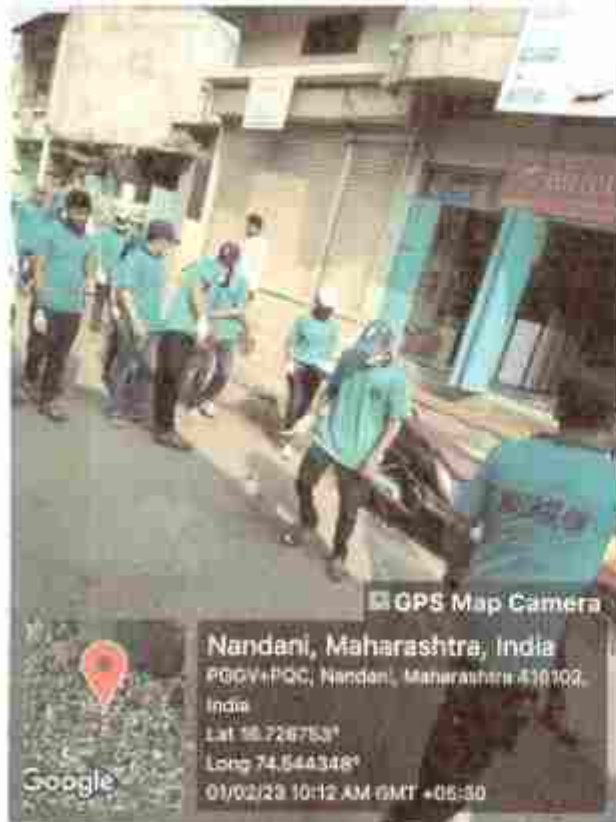

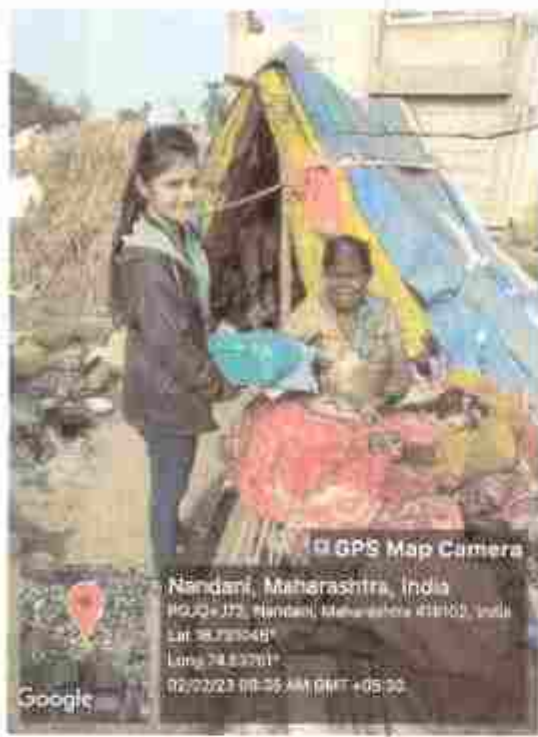
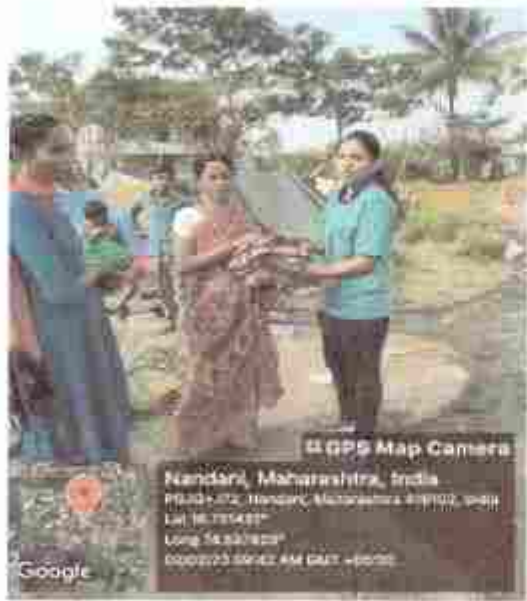
### Cloth Donation camp:

#### Plastic Free India Street Play:

India's ban on select single-use plastic items comes into effect from July 1, 2022. Although this is the country's first attempt to regulate plastics available in the market, it will send out the wrong message if we say "India is banning single-use plastic".

This is because even after July 1, the Indian market will continue to sell a gamut of single-use plastic items like soft drinks and mineral water bottles, all products sold in multi-layered packaging, among others. These plastic items perfectly fit the bill for single-use plastic going by the definition India has adopted.

India defined single-use plastic in an August 12, 2021 notification as "plastic item intended to be used once for the same purpose before being disposed of or recycled"

To make people aware of the ill-effects of plastic, the NSS volunteers of our college has started organizing street plays to spread the message of 'say no to single-use plastic'.

We organized a street play at Nandani village on the theme "Environmental Protection and Plastic Ban" on 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2023. Many volunteers participated in the street play with an objective to create awareness amongst the public, the importance of greenery and planting more trees in order to reduce environmental pollution for the survival of animals and mankind. They also highlighted the effects of usage of plastic bags to the public. Street Play was followed by the
